About Nilanga:

Nilanga is a taluka place in Latur district of Maharashtra, near Karnataka border. This city has a historical heritage. There are a large number of ancient and medieval art and architecture. It has Nilakantheshwar (Harihareshwar) temple which is historically important in terms of architecture and sculpture of Hemadpanthi type of Chalukya period of Kalyani. Apart from this area also has historical temples at Bhootmugali and Talikhed. The Dargahs of Muslim saints like Pirpasha and Dadapeer in the town also represent religious harmony. This area was a part of Nizam's State in Hyderabad. The Arya Samaj Movement in Nilanga has made a special contribution in the Hyderabad freedom struggle. Therefore, this area has also got the historical legacy of freedom struggle. Along with this, 10 km from Nilanga city, on Nilanga-Latur highway is the heritage site of the historic 'Kharosa Caves.' The city of Nilanga is connected by highways to the cities like Mumbai, Pune, Solapur, Nanded, Hyderabad and Gulbarga.

About the College:

Former Chief Minister of Maharashtra State Late. Dr. Shivajirao Patil Nilangekar with the aim of providing quality education to the rural and grassroots students of Nilanga area, founded Maharashtra Shikshan Samiti in 1968. Maharashtra Mahavidyalaya was established in 1970 with the motto 'Nahi Gyanen Sadrishyam Pavitrameeh Vidya'. The college is permanently affiliated to Swami Ramanand Teertha Marathwada, University Nanded; and is one of the reputed colleges in the university area. The college has been reaccredited by NAAC three times so far, and the college has received B+ grade (CGPA-2.62) in the third reaccreditation. The College is recognized under (2f) and (12B) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956. The parent university has also conferred the award for the Best College in rural areas. About the Seminar

On the occasion of the 75th year of Independence, the entire country is celebrating the "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav". In this background, while organizing a seminar on 'Maharashtra's Contribution in Indian Freedom Struggle', the main objective is to shed light on such a freedom movement and bring about a constructive discussion on various known and unknown aspects of the freedom movement. It is very important to keep in mind that Maharashtra is the then Marathi speaking region while discussing the presented topic. Because the state called Maharashtra came into existence after independence i.e. on 1st May 1960. Therefore, it is important to keep in mind the limitations of the

present state of Maharashtra and the then Marathi speaking region in the time frame of the freedom struggle while discussing the presented topic. In this region it is necessary to include the region of Marathwada in present day Maharashtra which is in the periphery of Hyderabad state. This issue needs to be discussed keeping in mind that the struggle of the subjects against the institution was a part of the freedom movement itself.

India's independence is the result of a long struggle for freedom against the British rule. The Indian started to oppose the British rule from the beginning itself But this opposition was not that impressive. In fact there was not could challenge the British power. The Uprising of 1857 was the first challenge to British rule. If we consider in relation to Maharashtra, in Maharashtra the British rule, established in 1818 A.D. was opposed from the beginning. Before 1857, the revolt of Ramoshi, Bhilla and Koli was also a major challenge to the British power in Maharashtra. Even during the 1857 uprising, the events that took place in various places in Maharashtra are of special importance. This uprising created the background for the future freedom struggle. This uprising was suppressed by the British power with its military might.

This incident gradually worked to awaken the political consciousness among the Indian people and it was from this that the National Congress (Sabha) was formed. Through that, the challenge given by the Indians collectively to the British power was to increase the scope of the freedom struggle. Many movements of this period made the freedom struggle more mature. The emergence of various socio-religious organizations also became an inspiration for the freedom struggle. Along with that, various political, social, religious, educational and cultural changes in Maharashtra were mainly motivating the freedom movement. There are many aspects of the Indian freedom struggle. Apart from that, the contribution of common people remained equally important in this freedom movement. Many group elements who contributed significantly in the freedom struggle are still marginalized. This seminar is intended to have a constructive discussion on such factors.

A Brief Report

Inauguration Ceremony:

Dr. Umesh Bagade Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, Department of History as key note speaker for this seminar, was present. Retired Principal of Mahatma Basaveshwar College, Latur Dr. Somnath Rode, Retired Head of Department of History, Maharashtra College Hon'ble Manohar Sangve, Honorable Professor Dr. Indira Suryawanshi Osmania University Hyderabad, Mr. Bhujang Bobde, Coordinator, Department of Archives and Museums, Hyderabad, Chief Coordinator, Principal Dr. M.
