It has been quite a few months since we last wrote to you. None of us had probably imagined how our lives would change in this duration.

At Paani Foundation, it has been a unique and challenging time. COVID-19 has led us to re-imagine several aspects of our work. For the first time ever, our physical, residential trainings have taken on a digital avatar. We have recently launched these sessions for almost 1,000 villages participating in the Samruddha Gaon Spardha. More on that, in the coming weeks.

In the last few months, we have also received hundreds of emails and messages from people who've bared their hearts and shared personal stories of hardship amid the pandemic. A feeling of hopelessness, exhaustion, isolation and uncertainty has been palpable.

So today, we wanted to reach out and share with you a symbol of hope and healing - a living, breathing example of how it is possible to recover, regenerate, and blossom again.

Jalmitra, in September 2018, in partnership with SayTrees Environmental Trust, we planted 2,000 saplings on a small, barren patch of land in Satara district's Nhavi Budruk village. Planted as per the Miyawaki technique, our mission was to grow a forest rapidly, and begin to give back to nature what we humans have so ruthlessly destroyed.

And as two years passed and September 2020 arrived, we witnessed an almost unbelievable transformation.

Some tips before you head out to your village:

- 1) Please remember Shramdaan will be physical labour; so wear comfortable clothing and closed shoes.
- 2) Please remember your health comes first. We have only a first aid kit on site.
- 3) Please don't forget to carry sun protection (a hat, or sun block).
- 4) Please carry adequate water for you and your group as it will be hot.
- 5) Please carry some snacks, as there are limited options in the villages.
- 6) You may want to print out the directions from Google Maps to the village beforehand, as mobile network is sometimes poor once you leave the highways.
- 7) Take a break from time to time during Shramdaan, even if it's only to take in the surroundings and make new friends!
