The second instalment of Rs. 50,000/- will be released on receipt of the following documents that may please be submitted within two months after holding the seminar:

- I. Two complete sets of Reports (hard bound copies) of the seminar/Conference that should necessarily constitute of the following:
 - The List of the Actual Participants of the seminar.
 - The exact titles & presenters of each of the session.
 - 2-3 paragraphs write-up on seminar topic.
 - Proceedings of Seminar.
 - A note on the contribution of the seminar to the existing body of research.
- II. The audited head-wise statement of accounts and utilization certificate in GFR (form 12A) (copy enclosed) for the entire expenditure incurred from the sanctioned amount. Both these needs to be duly certified by the Convener, Registrar/Principal, and the Finance Officer in case of the Central University or the Chartered Accountant in case of other institutions.

Kindly ensure that the Utilization Certificate and the Statement of Expenditure must be duly verified and properly stamped by the Principal/Registrar/Head of the Institution and the Finance Officer/Chartered Accountant as the case may be.

The above documents are mandatory requirement to settle the account and enable us to release the final installment.

The following are the other conditions that shall be complied with:


- The financial assistance should be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned.
- A part of the assistance is to be utilized for publication of the proceedings of the seminar
- On International travel (not more than 25% of the total budget) is to be allocated.
- Obtaining MEA Clearance wherever necessary is the responsibility of the organizers
- The amount sanctioned herein is to be utilized on the proposed conference only within the stipulated period.
- Any amount of the assistance remaining unspent during the current financial year shall be refunded to the ICSSR immediately after completion of the seminar/conference. If the organization do not refund the amount in time, it will be required to refund the amount of the grant with interest thereon @ 10% per annum from the date of release of grant from ICSSR.
- As per the directives from the Government of India, all the payment are to be made by e-payments only. Kindly furnish the information in the PFMS form duly verified by the administrative head of the Institution/University & College after ensuring that the account has been linked with the ICSSR.

The expenditure will be debited to the budget head "General (OH31) NIS- (National & International Seminars)".

Report of the Seminar

One Day National Seminar entitled “—*Roles and Responsibilities in Effective Implementation of National Education Policy-2020*”, sponsored by The Indian Council of Social Science Research, New Delhi under the theme *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav* was organized by our college on the date as communicated to you, i.e. on 13th August, 2022. The schedule of the seminar was divided into various sessions commencing from Inauguration Ceremony followed by two Plenary Sessions before the Lunch Break and two post-lunch Technical Sessions or Paper Reading Sessions. The seminar was concluded by the Valedictory and Certificate Distribution Ceremony.

The registration process for the seminar started at 09.30 am at the venue of the seminar. The Inauguration Ceremony of the seminar was started at 10.00 am under the chairmanship of Hon. Mr. Vijay Shivajirao Patil Nilangekar, the President of our parent institution Maharashtra Shikshan Samiti Nilanga. The seminar was inaugurated by the auspicious hands of Hon. Dr. Jogendrasinghji Bisen, Pro-Vice-Chancellor of Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded. Among the other dignitaries on the dais were Dr. M. N. Kolpuke, Principal of hosting institution, Convener of the seminar Dr. D. S. Choudhari, and Prof. Liliana Espicia, a research scholar from Columbia and organizing secretaries Dr. D. H. Jadhav, Dr. B. S. Gaikwad, Dr. A. B. Dhalgade, Mr. Srinivas Gaikwad, and Mr. R. S. Madarse.

The inaugurator Hon. Dr. J. M. Bisen, the Pro-Vice- Chancellor of S. R. T. M. University Nanded shared his opinion that the NEP-2020 will be highly beneficial in providing jobs to the youths in India. The policy has a potential to tap into the repertoire of skills in the traditions of India and generate not just the jobs but also new entrepreneurs. The students should focus on their studies as well as the other hard skills and soft skills too. The teachers should remove the misconceptions regarding the policy by understanding and studying the policy thoroughly and

communicate the same to the stake holders of the society. He also expected that, the teachers will understand the roles and responsibilities meant by the policy makers in order to effectively implement the policy. He said that we as a nation need to dream and work hard to realize the dream of making India a 'global knowledge hub' and a 'vibrant knowledge society' as envisioned by the policy. In his address the chairperson of the inaugural function Hon. Mr. Vijay Patil Nilangekar argued that all the higher education institutes need to fully understand, adapt to and adopt the NEP-2020. There is need for doing the timely changes in the existing order of the practices in pedagogy and he also expected that the teaching fraternity and the key persons in the implementation of the policy will surely work towards reducing the dropout rates and generating jobs for the employable youths. Moreover, he also emphasized on making the students employable by bridging the gap between the present skills and the skills demanded in the market.

In her Keynote Address Dr. Divya C. Senan, Professor, Department of Education, University of Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram enlightened upon the implementation process in the phased manner. She clarified that the policy will be implemented in a way where the next phase of the policy will be rolled out only after successful implementation of the previous step. She brought the recent best trends in higher education all across the globe which she said, can be highly useful in our contexts. She elaborated on the skills based, vocational education and holistic development of the students through education. She argued that the credit system will be a way for evaluating, rewarding and banking upon the academic and practical skills of the students. She shared her erudite opinions on the new pedagogical and curricular structure. She finally brought to attention of the delegates what the policy expects from the higher education institutes. She opened the seminar for further discussions on the roles and responsibilities of higher education institutes in effective implementation of the policy.

The first Plenary session was chaired by Dr. P. M. Mannikar, Vice-Principal and Head of P. G. and Research Department of English, Dayanand College of Arts, Latur and the key note speaker was Dr. Vaijayanta Patil, I/c Dean, Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies and the member of NEP Implementation Committee formed by Maharashtra Government. She focused on the pedagogical practices to be carried out in order to meet the demands of the time in order to have 'an education system that is second to none' as planned by the policy makers. The chairperson Dr. P. M. Mannikar elaborated on MOOCs, Blended, Virtual and Experiential learning as well as Open, Life-long learning. His focus was on making the best use of these supplementary modes of learning by the higher education institutes. He brought forth the challenges in this enterprise and its prospects in the future.

In the Second Plenary session the resource person Dr. D. N. More, Professor, Department of English, People's College, Nanded and Ex-Member of Senate of S. R. T. M. University, Nanded, pointed out the key challenges in maintaining the quality in higher education and the changing role of NAAC. He put forward the present budgetary allocations for higher education and its implications for the future of higher education. He focused the means of economizing on expenses by the higher education institutes and the need for generating funds through various means like outsourcing, counseling and patent registration and so on. He also focused the need for understanding and bridging the gap between digital divides in the country in order to achieve the equality across all the sections in the society. Chairperson Dr. Vishnu Patil, Coordinator, IQAC, Deogiri College, Aurangabad presented his paper on Artificial Intelligence and future employment as well as challenges in uniform curriculum framework and ways to remedy them.

In the next two technical sessions were chaired by Dr. R. D. Kamble, Principal, Moreshwar College, Ganga Masla, Dist. Beed and Dr. P. D. Shitole, Head, Department of English, Smt. S. D. Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Latur. The research scholars presented their research papers in English and Marathi language. In total, 62 scholarly research papers were presented in the two parallel sessions spanning more than 4 hours. 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Editorial

We are so glad that we, the editorial team, are presenting this special issue of the reputed International Peer Reviewed Research Journal Vidyawarta on the occasion of One Day National Seminar on "Roles and Responsibilities of Higher Education Institutes in Effective Implementation of National Education Policy-2020" sponsored by Indian Council of Social Sciences, New Delhi (ICSSR) under the theme of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav organized by Maharashtra Mahavidyalaya, Nilanga Dist. Latur on 13 August, 2022. We wholeheartedly thank the ICSSR, New Delhi for this golden opportunity to serve our nation and also the president of our Maharashtra Shikshan Samiti Hon. Mr. Vijay Patil Nilangekar Saheb for his constant inspiration and valuable guidance to make this a grand event.

It is a great pleasure to share with you all that our request for papers gathered a huge response from erudite academicians, research scholars, pedagogues and educationists. The research papers deal with almost all the aspects of National Education Policy-2020. There are research papers dealing with roles and responsibilities of higher education institution as well as the solutions and remedies to the issues and challenges to the effective implementation of the policy.

As you are well aware, on 29th July, 2020, the Government of India launched the National Educational Policy replacing the thirty-four years old National Policy on Education (1986). After two years since its launch, it has now come to the stage of its phase-wise implementation all over the nation. As it is well known and received with appreciation, the policy has very timely brought in many sweeping changes in our existing educational system. Many unprecedented changes are in the pipeline of implementation. The policy decrees that the implementation will be guided by the principles like –first the intent and spirit of the policy will be of high importance, followed by phased implementations of the policy where, the next phase will be rolled out only after ensuring the successful implementation of the previous one. As such, it is of utmost priority for the higher educational institutes, being one of the main agents of change in our education system, to understand and align with the National Education Policy-2020.

To summarise only the take away points of the policy, it is noteworthy that, in order to develop a good, thoughtful, well rounded and creative individual, the NEP-2020 aims to create large and multidisciplinary colleges and HEI clusters with academic and administrative autonomy. It also aims to create an autonomous body, the National Educational Technology Forum (NETF), to provide a platform for the free exchange of ideas on the use of technology to enhance learning, assessment, planning, administration. To fund outstanding peer-reviewed research and to actively seed research in universities and colleges, the policy envisions to establish a National Research Foundation (NRF).

It has set a goal of curtailing drop-out rates from higher education and increase the enrolment ratio from the present 26.3% to 50% by 2035 (NEP 10.8). Invoking the old Gurukul system of imparting the knowledge and skills through reverence for teachers, the policy endeavours to reinstate teacher at the centre of teaching and learning activities. To provide flexibility to the students at the undergraduate level, it proposes the Academic Bank of Credits and a more holistic and multi-disciplinary approach consequently strengthening the Choice Based Credit System. The pupils will have common entrance test for all and also, they will be offered courses with

multiple exit points. By 2025, at least 50% of the pupils are proposed to have exposure to vocational education.

As such, it is opportune to discuss and be prepared for the implementation of the National Education Policy-2020 when it aims to bridge the gap between the current state of learning outcomes and what is required through undertaking major reforms that bring the highest quality, equity, and integrity into the system from early childhood care and education through higher education. In response to the call of the policy makers, the higher educational institutes have to align and if needed, reorient themselves in accordance with the policy. The proposed seminar is an endeavour to create awareness in higher education institutes to deliberate on the roles so as to shoulder the responsibilities of making India a knowledge superpower. We are hopeful that this special issue will be instrumental in providing a document of importance to understand, analyse and reorient ourselves for making NEP-2020 a blue-print for a huge transformation of India.

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
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
