Introduction

It is important that the college develops a mechanism for providing benefits of scholarship schemes to the eligible students. Therefore, to monitor the entire process of applying to various scholarship schemes, providing technical assistance, and data collection, the Scholarship Monitoring Committee is formed by the college. The committee informs the students through notices to register their names on the government portal. A separate window is created by the college to fill the forms of the students. A technical expert is also appointed to fill the forms on the MahaDBT Portal of government of India as per the government rules and regulations. The designated staff personnel provide all kind of technical and documentary support to the students. The college has also started two scholarship and freeship schemes for the students. The merit scholarship scheme is aimed at motivating the students and the freeship scheme is a helping hand extended by the college to the needy students as per the vision and mission of the college.

A) Objectives of the Policy

- To ensure that all the eligible students avail of the benefits of the GOI and other scholarships and freehsips
- 2. To facilitate and provide technical assistance to the students for the process of applying for the schemes.
- 3. To monitor the entire process whereby no eligible student is left bereft of his/her due benefits
- 4. To increase enrolment in the higher education and provide help to the students belonging to the low-income groups.
- 5. To systematically complete the task of applying to the scholarship schemes, data collection and submission to the IQAC.

B) Types of Scholarship/Freeship Schemes

- 1. Government of India and State Govt. Scholarships
- 2. NGO Scholarships
- 3. Institution Funded Scholarship
- 4. Institution Sponsored Freeship

1. GOI Scholarship State Government Scholarships

The Central Govt. of India and the State Governments provide more than 600 scholarships for various purposes and eligibility groups with an aim to appreciably increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio of SC and ST students in higher education. The focus of the schemes is on the students from the poorest households to provide them financial assistance at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage so that they are enabled to complete their education. The amount is transferred through a government policy of the Direct Benefits Transfer (DBT). DBT aims to bring transparency, eliminate misuse of funds and enable enhanced monitoring of the Schemes implemented by the Government of India.

Following Government of India and Maharashtra State Government Scholarship schemes are implemented in the college for the students.

2) NGO Scholarships

Besides the above mentioned central and state government funded scholarship schemes, our college also facilitates and provides support for availing the NGO coordinated scholarships under CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) funds. Maharashtra Mahavidyalaya has two programmes to which no government scholarship schemes are applicable. Maharashtra Mahavidyalaya strives by various such ways to help the needy students. The students from our college belong to the low income groups irrespective of their caste, creed or gender are encouraged and helped to apply to the schemes. The college works as a facilitator and counselor to the applying students. The college reaches out to the Non-Govt. Organizations authorized for CSR funds transfer. The college ensures that the students duly submit their applications and the amounts are transferred directly into their bank accounts. The college has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with Dream Chaser's Academy, Latur for smooth process of applying and expert support to the students. Apart from government scholarships the college provides self-funded scholarships to the meritorious students. With a vision that the college needs to find out means to provide free ships to the students learning in the non-grant-in-aid degree or post graduate programs. In accordance with a vision and mission of the college, we ensure that the students from the low income groups also get quality education and support for completion of their degrees. There are the following two schemes initiated by the college.

3) Institution Funded Scholarship- Late Dr. ShivajiraoPatilNilangekarSaheb Merit Scholarship Scheme

[This section of the policy is modified in February 2021] The teachers in our college have sponsoredthis scheme for the meritorious students every year to encourage their academic excellence. The teachers have resolved that after the sad demise of Hon. Dr. ShivajiraoPatilNilangekarSaheb, a great visionary leader, former Chief Minister of Maharashtra & Founder President of M. S. S. Nilanga, on 05/08/2020, as a homage to his visionary contribution to the educational empowerment of Nilanga Tehsil, the existing award scheme be reintroduced since the

academic year 2020-21 as "Late Dr. ShivajiraoPatilNilangekarSaheb Merit Scholarship Scheme" so that the next generations of students will be inspired. Likewise, the scheme is continued by the new title. Every year, more than 60 students are benefitted by the scheme.

4) Institution Sponsored Freeship

Maharashtra Mahavidyalaya continuously takes efforts to extend its helping hand to the students from humble backgrounds by providing various kinds of helps them. Earn and Learn Scheme is one such initiative which provides skills to the students as well as much needed money for academic purposes. Likewise, there are many students who are desirous to learn new skills but unable to pay the fees. Maharashtra Mahavidyalaya runs two vocational skills programmes B. Voc. Web Printing Technology and B. Voc. Food Processing, Preservation and Storage. The students belonging to the low income families often face problems in fees submission. Therefore, Maharashtra Mahavidyalaya has started a scheme of Freeship whereby, around 50% fees of the two above mentioned programmes are waived off. The scheme is highly useful to the students who wish to learn the professional skills at our campus.

C) Facilitation and Support System for Scholarship

 The students will informed about the scholarship and freeship schemes through circulating the notices in the classrooms and in the social media groups.

- 2. The eligibility, the important dates and the scope of the schemes are circulated in the classrooms, displayed on the notice boards and on the website of the college.
- 3. The procedure of applying to the NGO scholarships, the eligibility criteria, the technical assistance and follow up is done by the college.
- 4. Computer laboratories will be made available for applying to the schemes online with a technical expert ready to assist.
- The necessary information regarding the schemes are made available in the prospectus of the college, on the college website and through a booklet circulated in the social media groups.
- 6. The students are informed about the freeship sponsored by the institution before they seek admission to the vocational programmes
- 7. The students are informed about the merit scholarship sponsored by the teachers time and again.
- 8. The NGO- Dream Chasers Academy, Latur- helps the students to submit their applications with required documents and a technical expert from the college assists the students in completing the procedure of application within the time stipulated.
- 9. A special committee monitors the entire procedure so that maximum number of students will be benefitted by the schemes.
- 10. A special staff member is designated to inform the students, complete the procedure, collect the data and submit the same to the IQAC at the end of the academic year.
- II. The college also attempts to collect scholarships, sponsorships, and charitable funds from Charity Trusts and Philanthropists.
