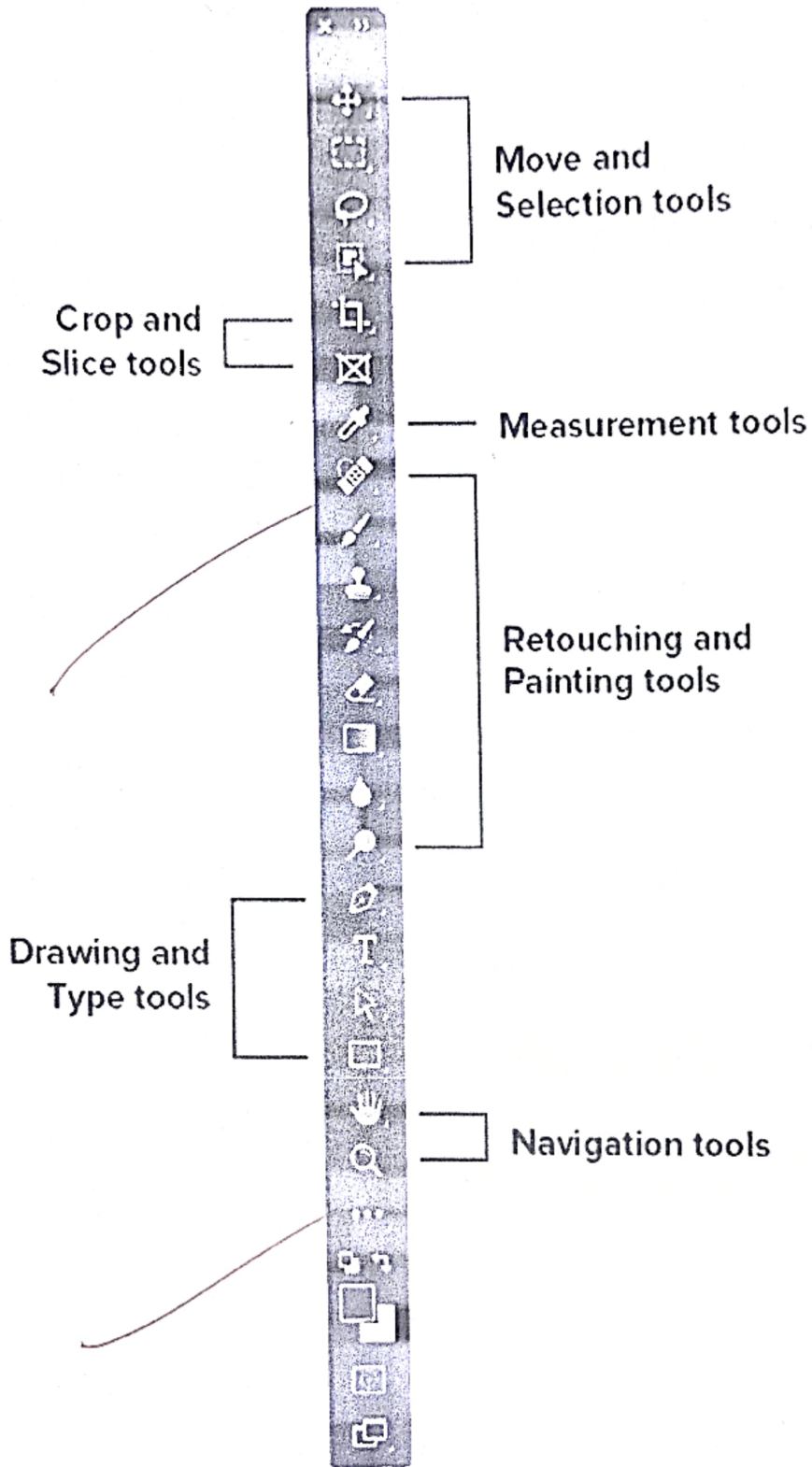

➤ **PHOTOSHOP CC**

Photoshop CC is the standard for photo editing and manipulation. It allows the user to make precise edits to their photos as well as improve the overall quality of the subject in the photo. It is also used by graphic designers that don't want to use illustrator. Photoshop is targeted toward creative hobbyists and professionals, but it's easy to use (in my opinion) interface allows any joe shmoe off the streets to learn and use it. The CC in the name is saying that it is part of Adobe Creative Cloud, which is Adobe's annual subscription program. It succeeds Adobe CS6 (which I still recommend if you like to own your programs).

1. TOOLBAR OVERVIEW
