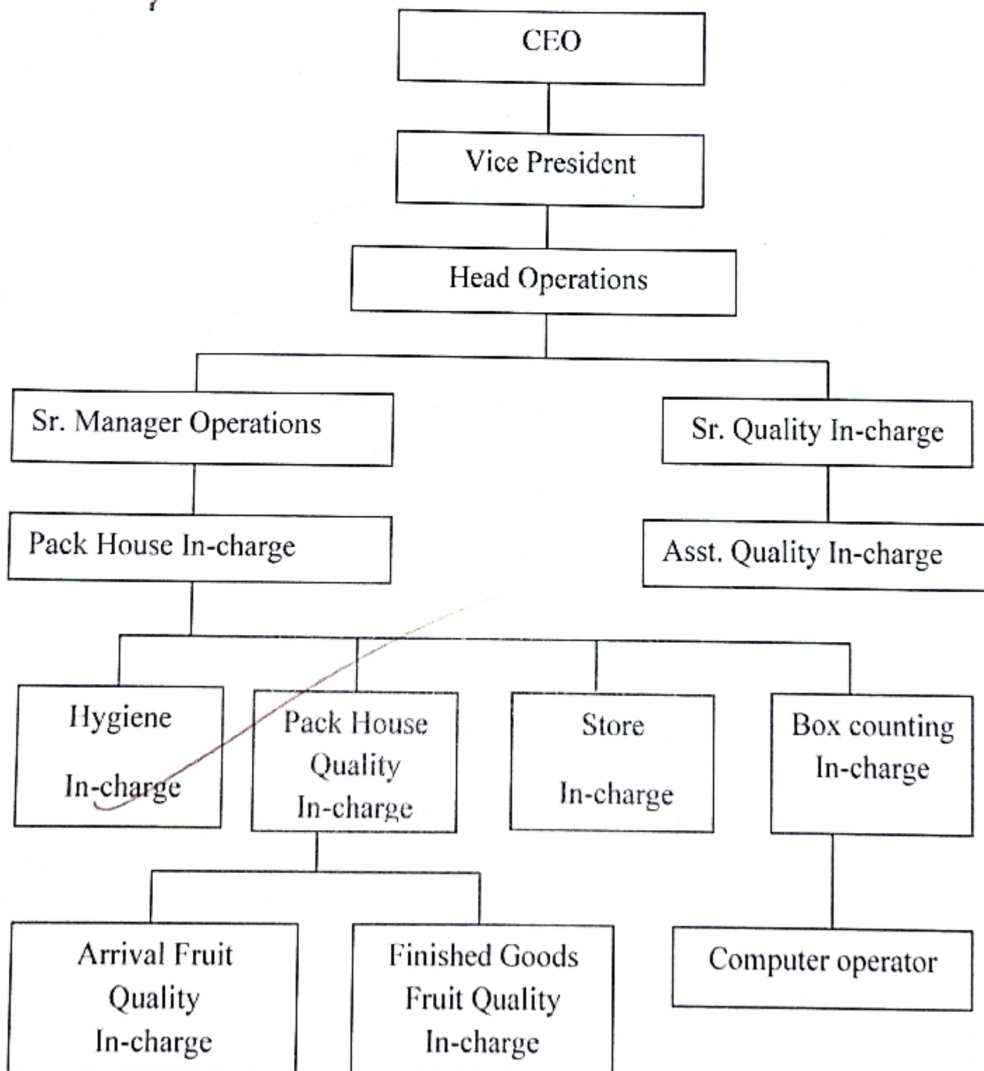


Figure.1.1 Staff organizational set up
