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
Report on feedback Analysis for Non-Teaching staff 2021-2022

Students Satisfaction Survey

Growth and development are continuous processes keeping this in view, on order to improve the internal quality ingredients of M. M. Nilanga, the Feedback Monitoring Committee is established. The feedback forms are collected, analyzed and the analysis report is prepared. The same is submitted to the IQAC for further processes and the necessary corrective measures and actions are taken. The Feedback Forms, Analysis and the Action Taken Reports are uploaded in the website. Feedback Monitoring Committee collected feedback from the students to improve the teaching learning processes and development of infrastructure in this academic year. The feedback analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey has brought to notice the following points.

- All students from all the programmes i.e. B.A. B.Com. B.Sc. B. C. A. and B.Voc. are satisfied regarding the completion of their syllabus and infrastructure which is given by the college for their future development.
- Responding to the question over syllabus completion, they have appreciated the teaching methods such as students-centric activities, practical, and projectile working.
- Students are satisfied about the completion of syllabus. About 98% students are satisfied about the completion of curriculum. The have responded


positively that syllabus was completed from 85 to 100% in each semester during this year.

- Students are also satisfied about the evaluation process. The internal tests, the practical examinations, and the entire evaluation process is deemed as satisfactory by the students.
- The internal examination process works towards the improvement of the students so that the students improve their quality and overcome their weaknesses in various subjects.
- Regarding the active interest of the students in promoting the students to internships, field visits, and bank visits etc. to enable them to acquire the on-field knowledge. To the students of B. Voc., the internship is made mandatory in the syllabus. They are sent to the industry for internships. By the activity of internship, the application of knowledge is done in the skillful manner. The students have shown satisfaction over the implementation of the internships.
- The B.Voc. (FPPS) and (WPT) programmes are helpful to the students to become self-employed rather than depending on the government jobs and making them earning. The students have expressed satisfaction.
- Students are also satisfied on the ICT tool based teaching methods because by using Android smart TVS, digital boards and OHP projectors etc. tools teachers give interpretive and comprehensive lectures and make the concept so easy.
- Students have responded that there is a strong bonding relation between teacher and students and every faculty members identify strength and weakness of the students and make them aware to use their potential according to their interests.
- Many students also appreciated about the excursion tours because practical learning is the most important aspect of the life to absorb direct knowledge through the visit to the various spots and complete the curricular activity.

- The students have expressed that the college provides all the infrastructural facilities for their all-round development.
- The students have responded to the question whether college provides mentoring and counseling services to the students or not? They have responded that mental and social well-being of the students is taken care of and therefore, students are satisfied about the participation and benefits of these activities in their life.
- For environment conservation, extension activities like tree plantation programs through NSS, NCC etc. are organized.
- Every year organizing workshops, seminars are organized professional ethics, gender equality programs, IPR etc. make the students aware of these issues.
- In the B. Sc., students have blood detection as a practical hence the blood group detection activities are carried out in the college which helps them easily identify their own blood group by using the tools.
- In our college under the campaign *Arogyam Dhan Sampada* every year there is health checkup ,blood group, detection, blood donation, free check of hemoglobin percentage of the students, and free B. P. check-up of the staff non-teaching staff is regularly done.
- Our college collects the funding from the teachers students and non-teachings staff to needy peoples such as Kerala flood relief , Cancer patient, Accident patients and temporary workers which are present in the university economically poor background and disable students.
- For the development of ethical value every faculty members tries to inculcate the ethics which is hidden behind the teaching content and explain all these ingredients to the students and to make their life reach in ethical values. Over all the above mentioned activities the students have expressed their satisfaction.

suggestions of the student for the college

- 1. Student suggested to start departmental library for the quick resources.
- 2. Students expected to provide practical apparatus in extra-quantity for the students.
- 3. Student are interested in the civil services competitive examination so they advised to start civil services examination guidance in the college.
