



- It is also agree that the detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions.
- Student Exchange

Both the Institutions Dept. of Commerce agree that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

- Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution. b)
- An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution. c)
- His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.

- f) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence between courses taken at the host institution vis-a-vis those offered at the home institution.
- If an exchange student has undertaken research project, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research project, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research project carried out.
- If an exchange student has undertaken research project, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.

D. Exchange of Faculty

Both Institutions Dept. of Commerce agree to encourage collaboration between facultyof the Dept. of Commerce. Specifically, institution will encourage members of Dept. of Commerce to undertake short visits to, or take up specific visit for Teaching, Examination, Evaluation and for assignments etc. each other's institution as per the existing norms.

Exchange of Study Material:

Each Institutions Dept. of Commerce will exchange information on teaching/learning material, research activities and other relevant programmes.

Collaborative Activities:

Both Institutions Dept. of Commerce agree to organize joint Conferences, workshops and courses and also agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops and courses.

G. Co-ordination:

Each institution Dept. of Commerce shall appoint one member of its teachingfaculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. The Coordinator from the each side will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

H. Tenure and Termination:

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for next five years, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advanc




