Objectives of the Activity:

- 1. Contextual understanding: The documentary can provide a visual representation of the Lake District's natural beauty, helping students understand the context of Wordsworth's poetry and the inspiration behind his works.
- 2. Imagery and description: By seeing the landscapes, mountains, and lakes that influenced Wordsworth, students can better appreciate his vivid imagery and descriptions in poems like "I Wandered Lonely as a Cloud" (Daffodils).
- 3. Nature and its role: The documentary can highlight the importance of nature in Wordsworth's poetry and life, demonstrating how it shaped his thoughts on beauty, tranquility, and the human experience.
- 4. Influence on Romanticism: The Lake District's majestic scenery can help students understand why Wordsworth and other Romantic poets were drawn to this region, fostering an appreciation for the movement's emphasis on nature and emotion.

Brief Report:

For the students of BA T. Y. Optional English a documentary on William Wordsworth's Lake District in England. The activity was organized in order to contextualize the understanding of the students whereby they will have a visual representation of the natural beauty of Lake District. The natural beauty as reflected in the poetry of William Wordsworth has its origin in the Lake District. The purpose behind organizing the activity was so that the students will understand the imagery of Landscapes, Mountains and lakes which have influenced his poetry. To understand the role of nature in the poetry of William Wordsworth it is necessary that the students should at least virtually visit the Lake District and have an informed imagination of his poems. To understand the influence of romanticism on the poetry of William Wordsworth and his followers it is necessary to know in which geographical context the poems were composed. Therefore, a documentary available on the YouTube was screened for the students on

the smart TV and the students were asked to closely observe the natural scenery shown in the documentary. Thereby, the students were expected to have an informed imagination regarding the contextual understanding of his poems. At the end of the lecture, the students were asked questions on the natural scenery they had observed in the documentary. The students responded to the questions and shared their oral feedback on the activity.


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
Outcomes of the activity
