**A Brief Report**

On behalf of the Department of History, on the occasion of Amrit Mahotsav of Hyderabad Liberation War, a study visit was conducted with the students to the historical heritage sites in Nilanga area. After this, the students should be aware of the historical heritage sites at the local level. A visit to local historical heritage sites was conducted with the aim of creating national consciousness among the students through the historical heritage of their locality and to study the historical instruments first hand.

Among these, study visits were made to places such as Nilkanteshwar temple of Kalyani Chalukya period, which is the deity of Nilanga city, Arya Samaj temple which inspired many youths of Nilanga area for the freedom struggle of Hyderabad and the Martyrs Memorial built in the memory of revolutionaries who contributed or martyred themselves in the freedom struggle of Hyderabad. On this occasion the Head of History Department Dr. S. G. Benjalwar, Prof. D. V. Pawar and Prof. Anuradha Mahajan guided the students about these historical heritage sites. A large number of students were present on this occasion.

- Students will be able to identify and explain the architectural features and symbolism used in the temple.
- Students will understand the importance of the temple in the local community and its contribution to the region's cultural heritage.



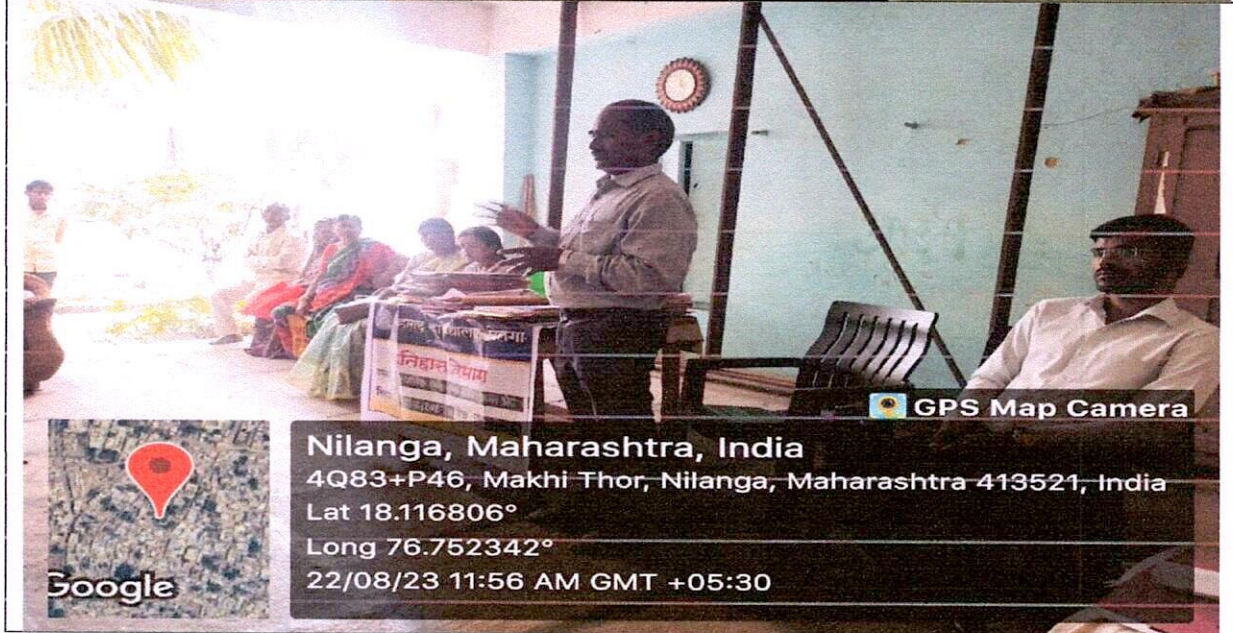
